PROGRAM SUMMARY

The COVID pandemic in 2020, coupled with other global disruptions like social unrest, changes in the geo-political environment, and political polarization, has emphasized the importance of planning amid perpetual uncertainty. The practice of strategic foresight – popularized by the Shell corporation in the 1970s – has recently seen a surge in demand as organizations recognize the need to plan for the many surprises that could affect their future. However, there are few experienced foresight practitioners – experienced in not just talking about the future, but skilled at how to apply this practice to deliver actionable results and show how they fortify strategic planning.

LBL Strategies has closed this gap. Offered in conjunction with George Washington University's Center for Excellence in Public Leadership, and part of the College of Professional Studies, Army Transformation: Strategic Foresight for Multi-Domain Operations will take participants through signal and trend scanning, scenario writing, workshop participation, and strategy development to prepare for the future. Successful completion of the program earns participants a certificate of completion from George Washington University's Center for Excellence in Public Leadership.

In addition to guest enrichment speakers from both public sector and private industry, participants will develop Trend Cards focused on discovery of signals and trends that could shape the future national security environment. The group will then select key drivers shaping the uncertain future operating environment, and write scenarios based on these selected drivers set 20 years in the future. Finally, through a lively, dynamic, and experiential workshop, participants will think about the future state and develop recommendations to address various aspects of Great Power Competition in the year 2042.

However, scenario work is not the end. In order to focus on execution, LBL Strategies will lead the team to out brief a key military audience, and then use the data to draft strategies to address the future national security environment. The result will be two weeks of strategic thought, strategic planning, and enrichment that can be applied as soon as participants return to their duty stations, and throughout their career.

Ms. Champ not only talks foresight, but she also applies it to real-world problems. Through a specially designed enrichment program, she will bring together leaders in the futures and foresight space to provide strategic, thought-provoking discussions aimed at challenging the status quo and opening up the aperture beyond what we "think" will "likely" happen in the future, to instead focus on the many possible futures and disruptions that could alter our best-laid plans.

Joining Ms. Champ is a line-up of academics, practitioners, and even Hollywood writers and best-selling authors to bring the future to life (see proposed agenda).



RICK BEYER

Rick Beyer is a best-selling author, an award-winning documentary producer, and a long-time history enthusiast. With a take on history that is both humorous and illuminating, he has appeared on CBS News, MSNBC, CNN, The

Discovery Channel, NPR and Fox News.

Rick wrote and produced the PBS documentary The Ghost Army, which premiered on PBS in 2013. It has been honored with a CINE Golden Eagle and audience awards at several film festivals. TV Guide called it "entrancing," while the LA Times referred to it as "fascinating, detailed, and oddly delightful." He also co-authored (with Elizabeth Sayles) the New York Times bestseller The Ghost Army of World War II. The book and documentary are currently being developed as a Hollywood movie by (American Sniper) producer Andrew Lazar and Universal Studios

Rick's most recent book, Rivals Unto Death was published in 2017. It is a dual biography of Alexander Hamilton and Aaron. It explores the story of their 30-year rivalry that ended in a deadly duel on the cliffs of Weekhawken, NJ. He is also the author of the popular Greatest Stories Never Told series of history books. Titles include The Greatest Stories Never Told, The Greatest War Stories Never Told, Greatest Presidential Stories Never Told, The Greatest Science Stories Never Told and Greatest Music Stories Never Told. Each contains 100 tales from history to "astonish, bewilder and stupefy." The Chicago Tribune described the first book as "an old-fashioned sweetshop full of tasty morsels," and the Army Times said of the second book: "Just when you thought you knew everything about everything, along comes Rick Beyer to prove you wrong."

He has produced films for PBS, The History Channel, National Geographic, the Smithsonian Institution, Historic Mount Vernon and others. His documentary credits include Expedition Apocalypse, The Wright Challenge, Secrets of Jamestown, The Patent Files and Timelab 2000, an acclaimed collection of 200 history minutes hosted by Sam Waterston.

A popular speaker who has engaged numerous audiences, Rick's topics include Artists of Deception: The Ghost Army of WWII, Rivals Unto Death: Hamilton and Burr, A Long Strange Trip: Tales from Music History, Getting to Eureka!, Confessions of a History Filmmaker, The Battle after the Battle: Lexington vs. Concord and the fight for Revolutionary Fame, and Rick's Rules of History. His presentations are spiked with humor, creative visuals and quirky props. They have proven popular at conferences, corporations, universities, libraries and other venues. Venues include the Smithsonian Institution in Washington DC and Music Teachers National Association Annual Conference in Los Angeles, CA.

Rick has written for The Daily Beast, History Channel Magazine, Politico.com, America in WWII, the Princeton Alumni Weekly, and other publications. He has also worked as a radio reporter, a TV news producer, an ad agency creative director, and a janitor (not in that order). He has curated a Ghost Army traveling museum exhibit, several Ghost Army art exhibits, and multiple exhibits for the Lexington Historical Society. 


PETER SINGER

Peter Warren Singer is Strategist at New America, a Professor of Practice at Arizona State University, and Founder & Managing Partner at Useful Fiction.

A New York Times Bestselling author, described in the Wall

Street Journal as "the premier futurist in the national-security environment" and "all-around smart guy" in the Washington Post, he has been named by the Smithsonian as one of the nation's 100 leading innovators, by Defense News as one of the 100 most influential people in defense issues, by Foreign Policy to their Top 100 Global Thinkers List, and as an official "Mad Scientist" for the U.S. Army's Training and Doctrine Command. No author, living or dead, has more books on the professional US military reading lists. His non-fiction books include Corporate Warriors: The Rise of the Privatized Military Industry, Children at War, Wired for War: The Robotics Revolution and Conflict in the 21st Century; Cybersecurity and Cyberwar: What Everyone Needs to Know and most recently LikeWar, which explores how social media has changed war and politics. It was named an Amazon and Foreign Affairs book of the year and reviewed by Booklist as "LikeWar should be required reading for everyone living in a democracy and all who aspire to." He is also the co-author of a new type of novel, using the format of a technothriller to communicate nonfiction research. Ghost Fleet: A Novel of the Next World War was both a top summer read and led to briefings everywhere from the White House to the Pentagon. His latest is Burn-In: A Novel of the Real Robotic Revolution. It has been described by the creator of Lost and Watchmen as "A visionary new form of storytelling—a rollercoaster ride of science fiction blended with science fact," and by the head of Army Cyber Command as "I loved Burn-In so much that I've already read it twice."

Previously, she was a SOCOM Strategy and Innovation Advisor conducting forecasting work on technology and the future operating environment. Dr. Kostopoulos has participated in the NATO Science for Peace Program, addressed the United Nations member states at the Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons Group of Governmental Experts (CCW GGE) meeting on Lethal Autonomous Weapons Systems (LAWS), done commissioned work for IEEE, and has been awarded the U.S. Presidential Service Award for her service to the cybersecurity community. Passionate about social technology awareness, she has an art series about Al and released an open-source game on technologies that affect humanity called Sapien 2.0.

Dr. Aaron Bazin is seasoned senior strategist and blockchain entrepreneur with two decades of strategic planning, organizational transformation, and executive

management experience for global enterprises, including: U.S. Special Operations Command, U.S. Central Command, U.S. Training and Doctrine Command, and NATO Allied Command Transformation. Currently, Aaron is a Senior Strategist with U.S. Special Operations Command; Strategy, Plans, and Policy Directorate. Aaron is also the President and Co-Founder of the VetCoin Foundation (501c3), a non-profit that harnesses the power of the blockchain, Web3, and Metaverse to connect, enable, and transform veteran communities. Aaron served in the U.S. Army for over 20 years and has experience in over 27 countries which included over 400 combat missions. Aaron has published over 30 articles, authored one book, and contributed to numerous others.



DR. RICHARD Lum

Dr. Richard Lum Richard is an academically trained futurist and chief executive of Vision Foresight Strategy LLC (VFS), a foresight and strategic analysis firm based

in Honolulu. His professional interests include the futures of governance, conflict and security, and industrialism. Richard's current and recent work for the Department of Defense includes research and concept work for US Special Operations Command, US Indo-Pacific Command, the Office of Naval Research, the F-35 Lightning II Program Office, and research and foresight work in support of Strategic Capabilities Office – West. He has briefed the White House, the US Secret Service, and the National Intelligence Council, as well as speaking at US Central Command, the Naval War College, the Association of the United States Army LANPAC, and SOFWERX.

Richard has worked with a wide variety of non-profit organizations, for-profit companies, and government agencies on foresight, strategy development, and strategic thinking. He has conducted foresight and strategy work on projects for organizations such as the European Commission, the UK government, the US Department of Defense, NASA, and PepsiCo. He has helped organizations apply foresight and develop strategy for endeavors ranging from the restoration of ancient Hawaiian island land management divisions to crowdsourcing foresight development to helping educators in the US anticipate the long-term futures of learning.

Richard is the author of 4 Steps to the Future: A Quick and Clean Guide to Creating Foresight and his contributions were featured in the books Thinking about the Future: Guidelines for Strategic Foresight (2006), A Careful Revolution (2019), Rethinking Asia 7: The Future of Work (2020), and Strategic Latency Unleashed: A SOF Perspective (2020). He has been published in the Journal of Futures Studies, the journal Futures, International Journal of System of Systems Engineering, World Future Review, and Small Wars Journal. He is the co-creator of the Verge General Practice Framework for foresight work, a framework used by foresight practitioners throughout the UK, in Europe, Africa, and Asia for horizon scanning, scenario development, and visioning work.

Richard is a member of the GeoTech Action Council at the Atlantic Council in Washington, DC and is a member of the HYFUTEC Expert Network at the European Centre of Excellence for Countering Hybrid Threats. He holds a PhD in Political Science from the futures studies program at the University of Hawai'i. His dissertation research focused on developing a conceptual framework for designing future governance systems.



DR. JAKE Sotiriadis

Dr. Jake Sotiriadis is the Director of the Center for Futures Intelligence at National Intelligence University (NIU). He is a member of the NIU research faculty and teaches

courses on international relations, intelligence tradecraft, and geopolitical futures. Jake is a frequent speaker on global futures and intelligence and founded the US Air Force's Strategic Foresight and Futures Team. He is also an advisor to the State Department and teaches courses at the Foreign Service Institute. Jake's work spans the nexus of disruptive technology, geopolitical risk, and futures intelligence. 
